Notification

F.No. Stds/Salt/Misc/01/FSSAI-2016 (pt-1).- The following draft of certain regulations, further to amend the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction on sales) Regulations, 2011, which the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India proposes to make with previous approval of the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 92 of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 (34 of 2006) is hereby published as required by the said sub-section (1) of section 92 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft regulations shall be taken into consideration after the expiry of the period of thirty days from the date on which copies of the Official Gazette in which this notification is published are made available to the public.

Objections or suggestions, which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft regulations before the expiry of period so specified, will be considered by the Food Authority.

Draft Regulations

1. **Short title and commencement-**(1) These regulations may be called the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction on sales)..... Amendment Regulations, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette

2. In the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restriction on sales) Regulations, 2011, in regulation 2.3, for sub-regulation 2.3.12, following shall be substituted namely: -

“2.3.12: Restriction on sale of common salt-No person shall sell or offer or expose for sale or have in his premises for the purpose of sale, common salt, for direct human consumption or for use as an ingredient in a food product unless the same is iodized:

Provided that common salt may be sold or exposed for sale or stored for sale for iodization, iron fortification, animal use, manufacturing medicines and industrial use, under proper label declarations, as specified in the Regulation 2.4.5 (21 & 42) of Food Safety and Standards (Packaging and Labelling) regulations, 2011.”
